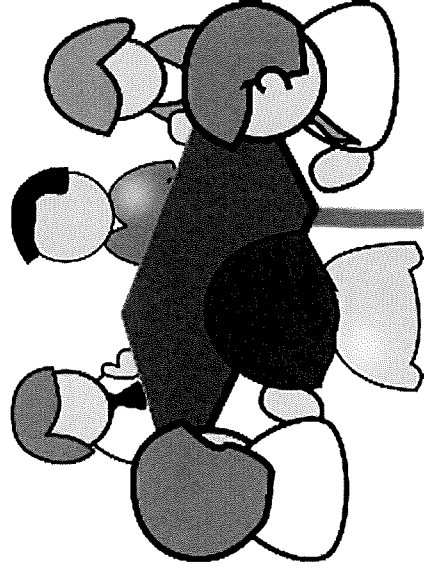

Opportunities At the school level

School Site Council-SSC

- ◆ Meets approximately 8 times per year
- ◆ Members : Parents, Teachers, Classified, and Administrator
- ◆ Membership is solicited annually and sent to all families

- ◆ Meetings are noticed and posted in advance at the school office, in the weekly update to parents, and on the school calendar.

- ◆ To give input on school-wide events, projects, and plans-secondary

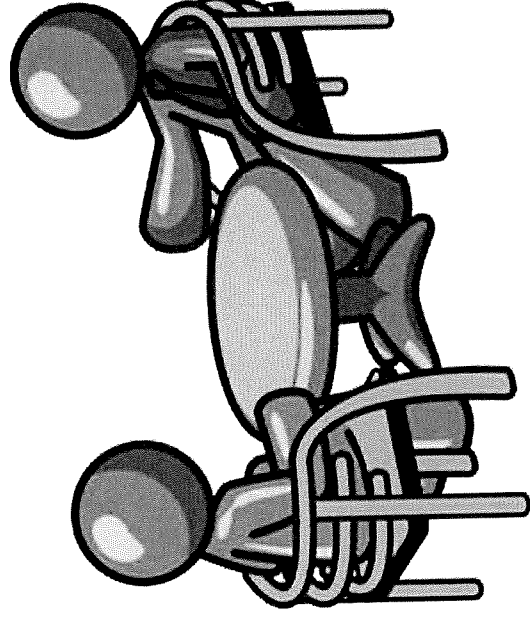
