### **Important Update:**

Dear Newcastle families,

Regrettably, due to COVID-19 staff-related health concerns, Newcastle Elementary and Charter will begin a two-week pause from in-person learning and return to full at home distance learning starting Monday, November 23rd and November 24th and continue for the week of November 30th - December 4th.

On December 7th, our students will return to their same Cohorts, same Cohort days, and Wednesday remains an at-home learning day for all students. The school day will be from 8 am to 2:30 pm. Students will eat lunch at school, Spanish, PE, and Music programs to resume a modified schedule.

As positive COVID-19 cases increase around our county, state, and country, we all need to be ready to transition in and out of in-person learning for the next several months. It is essential that families have alternative plans in place for when distance learning is at home. We will continue to work diligently to keep in-person learning operational.

The pause and return to distance learning are not negotiations related. The District and teachers group continue to negotiate in good faith on the impact and effects of the November 5th Board adopted return to school plan. The pause in in-person learning required us to push the start date out one week. We will continue to monitor current health and safety issues and adjust plan dates as necessary.

We are all anxiously awaiting the end of the pandemic and return to normal. Thank you for your support, grace, and understanding as we put student, family, and staff safety at the forefront of every decision.
