As you are aware we will continue to stay in distance learning for this week. We continue to prepare for extended day instruction beginning December 7th with our instructional day going 8am - 2:30 pm. We are prepared to serve lunches out of the cafeteria, grouped TK-2, 3-5 and 6-8. Students will be eating, appropriately socially distanced outside as long as the weather cooperates. If we need to move inside, we have prepared a safe, socially distanced lunch space for all classes. We have designated outdoor play areas for our students to engage in a variety of age-appropriate activities. When we return to extended day instruction, students will once again participate in PE, Spanish and Music.

We appreciate your commitment to ensuring that students who are symptomatic continue to stay home and quarantine as appropriate.
