Extended Day Hybrid Schedule begins Monday, December 7th!

On Monday, December 7th we begin our Extended Day Hybrid schedule. Our instructional day is 8:00 am - 2:30 pm. See schedule here. Students may either purchase a lunch from the cafeteria or bring their own lunch. Students will be eating, appropriately socially distanced, outside as long as the weather cooperates. If we need to move inside, we have prepared a safe, socially distanced lunch space for all classes. We have designated outdoor play areas for our students to engage in a variety of age-appropriate activities. Extended day in-person instruction includes students participating in PE, Spanish and Music.

We appreciate your continued commitment to ensuring that students who are symptomatic stay home and quarantine as appropriate.
