TK-8 students to attend 4-day/week in-person instruction begins 2/22!

TK-8 students in Cohorts A and B will now merge for in-person instruction on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday while students in Cohort C continue to receive instruction via live streaming. Wednesdays, all students will continue to have their morning meeting(s) from 8:00-8:30 am and then continue with asynchronous instruction for the remainder of the day.

With the majority of our students returning to in-person instruction over the next few weeks, please note that our teachers and staff will be working with classroom-based students to re-establish school expectations and routines. We kindly ask our Cohort C families to please extend extra grace and patience as our teachers navigate this new dynamic.

As a supportive measure, we are excited to announce that we have hired Cohort C instructional support! We welcome teachers Gracelyn Asay (pronounced AC) and Corinne Meigs who will be supporting our Cohort C student in collaboration with each student's classroom teacher. Cohort C students will be meeting their support teacher this week to begin building a positive relationship and to establish a schedule of support.
