Fentanyl Poisoning - You should have all received an urgent notification on Friday evening regarding students in our neighboring communities who are victims of fentanyl poisoning. <u>HERE</u> is a copy of the parent notification. As another informational source about the dangerous drug, <u>HERE</u> is the KCRA interview with the Rocklin family who experienced this tragedy just a couple of weeks ago.

Student Attendance: Students may *not* switch back and forth between in-person and distance learning. If your student is **not** physically at school (and the in-person learning option was selected), they will be marked absent. A call to the office/attendance line is necessary to clear the absence even if they log in for distance learning that day. If your child is currently designated in Cohort C and is not logged on when the teacher expects them, they will be marked absent. Again, a phone call to the office/attendance line is necessary to clear the absence. Attendance calls go out at 10:45 am each day.
