Limit 15 students. Suggested donation \$25



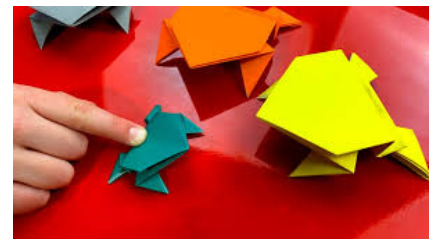
Students will take turns singing famous pop and Disney songs. While singing, students will practice reading the lyrics on the screen. Music and learning is so much fun!
